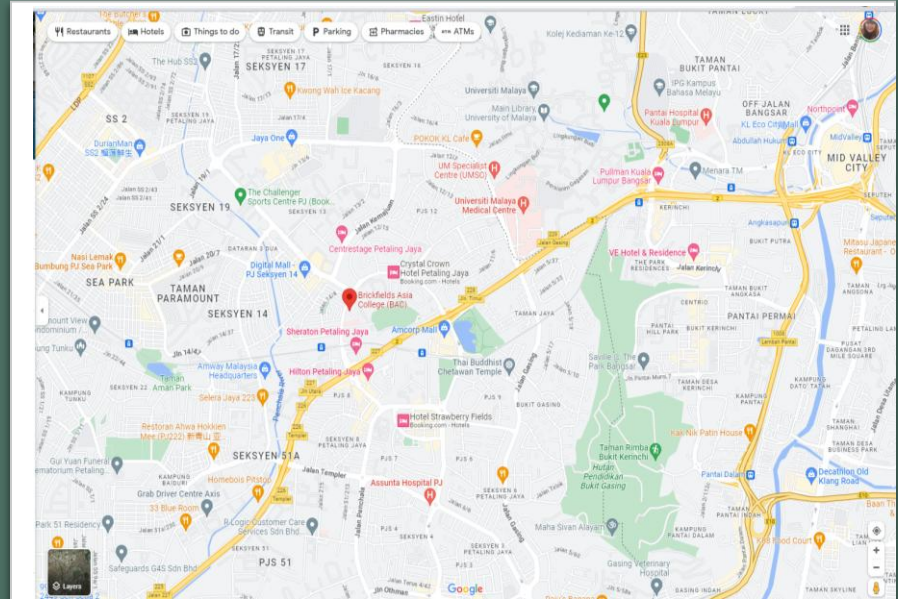

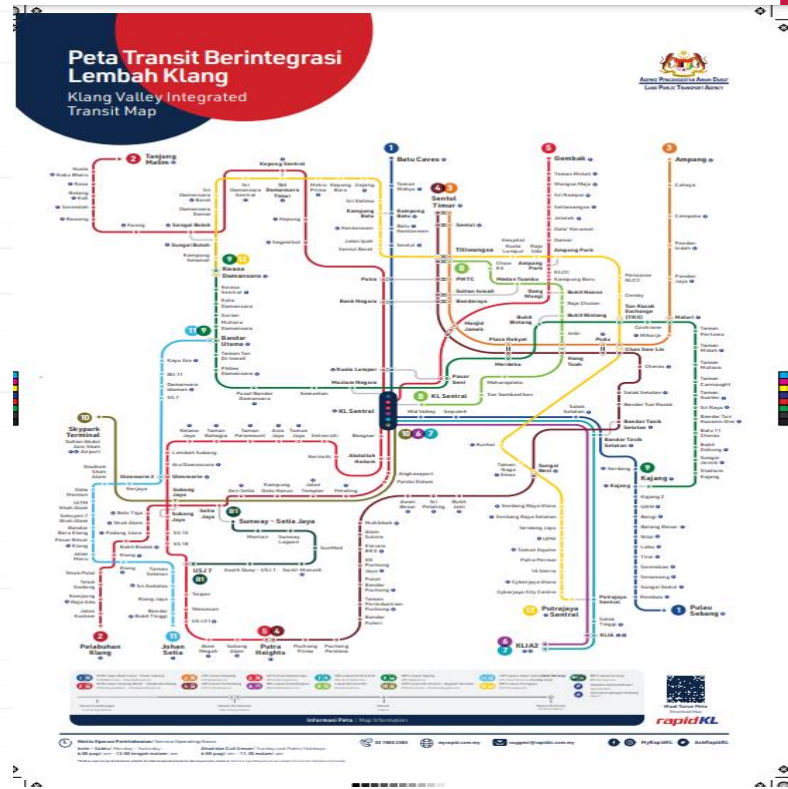

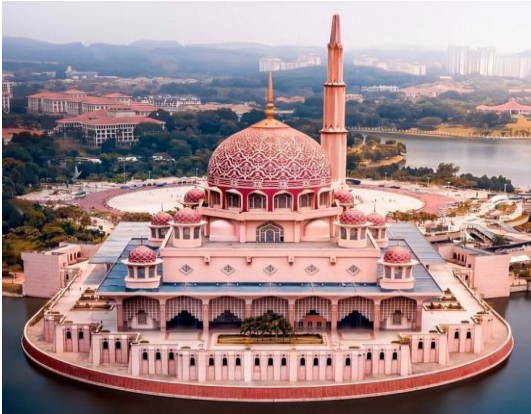

## PUTRAJAYA MOSQUE – BRIDGE



### **Putrajaya Bridge**

Putrajaya Bridge is the link between the Government Precinct and the Mixed Development Precinct, also linking the Boulevard and Putra Square. It's the most important bridge in Malaysia and it spans across 435 meters. It's also a unique icon landmark of Putrajaya. The architecture and design was inspired by Khaji Bridge, a famous bridge in Iran.

### **Putrajaya Mosque**

The Putra Mosque, or *Masjid Putra* is the principal mosque of Putrajaya, Malaysia. Construction of the mosque began in 1997 and was completed two years later. It is located next to Perdana Putra which houses the Malaysian Prime Minister's office and man-made Putrajaya Lake. In front of the mosque is a large square with flagpoles flying Malaysian states' flags

The Batu Caves are an important Hindu site and tourist attraction near Kuala Lumpur. Its main attraction is the large statue of the Hindu God at the entrance, besides a steep 272 climb up its steps to finally view the stunning skyline of the city centre.
